Visual Art - For students in 6th to 8th grades

Mondays 3:30 to 5:00 pm September 12 thru November 7

Students will explore the techniques of poetry, fiction, and nonfiction through writing exercises in a fun, open, and supportive environment. The emphasis of the workshop is to build on kids' imaginative approach to writing rather than emphasizing convention and correctness.
